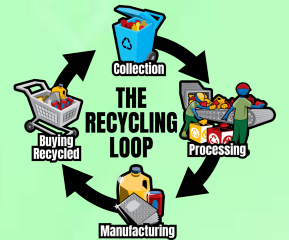
ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANUP AND RESTORATION
